## Rules and Regulations

USE TRAILS AT YOUR OWN RISK—THEY ARE NOT PATROLLED!

Ski or snowshoe safely at your own level.

Groomed cross-country ski trails are for the use of skiers only.

Snowshoe only on snowshoe trails. They are marked with orange trail tape and many tapes have the word TRAIL on them.

Enter and exit the trail system only at designated points – Main Parking Lot, Summit Parking Lot and Kallis Parking Lot.

Motorized vehicles are not permitted on or off trails.

For the safety of others and your pet, and for liability and insurance purposes, dogs are allowed on all snowshoe trails but only on ski trails marked “DOGS OK”. Skiers with dogs must register their dog and read the “Canine” section of the website under “Trail Info” [www.kelownanordic.com/trail-info/canine-trails/](http://www.kelownanordic.com/trail-info/canine-trails/).

Keep to the right; yield to skiers coming downhill or passing.

Please move off the trail when taking a break so others are free to continue.

Walk on ski trails only in emergencies. Walk on outside edges of trail only. Do not walk down the centre of the ski trail under any circumstances.

Help keep our cabins and trails clean. Please pack out what you pack in and take it home.

Fires are permitted only in stoves and designated fire pits.

Only instructors registered with the club may use the trails for paid instruction.

When crossing ski trails on snowshoes, please lift your snowshoes over the tracks. Watch for skiers coming from both directions.

## Canine Registration

All dogs accompanying members skiing or snowshoeing must be registered.

Dogs accompanying skiers must be off leash for safety purposes.

Dogs accompanying snowshoers may be leashed or off leash.

## Canine Rules and Regulations

Skijoring or being pulled by your dog is NOT permitted at any time on any of our trails.

Do NOT ski with your dog on a leash or attached to you in any way. It could become wrapped around your neck in a fall. Dogs that are not able to run unleashed without endangering other users are banned from our ski trails.

You may snowshoe with your dog on a leash.

Dogs are not allowed in any of the cabins.

Aggressive breeds or dogs and non-socialized dogs are NOT allowed anywhere at Kelowna Nordic.

Skiers with untrained dogs that chase other skiers or their dogs, are banned from our trail system.

Do not bag your dog poo unless you take it home with you. Just flick it off the trail with your poles.

Unless your dog stays near you or your vehicle in the carpark, it must be on a leash until you are skiing.
