- *All Trails are marked with orange tape with "Trail" on it
- *DO NOT FOLLOW OTHER TAPES OR TRAILS
- *Dogs are allowed on all snowshoe trails.
- *Dogs are NOT allowed in the cabins.
- *Aggressive dogs are NOT permitted anywhere on our trails.
- *Do not walk along ski trails, especially in the centre
- *If you are "lost", go back the way you came
- *Enter and exit the trail system only where designated
- *Do not make your own or new trails anywhere in our area
- *Plan your route to allow for return time
- *In emergency, walk on the outside of the ski trails only
